Matters Arising

Web Site - Charlotte Laine joined the meeting to meet with Councillor's to get suggestions for the Web Site, it proved to be very informative, she left with a good idea of what the Council requires, It was agreed that the domain name of the site would be www.felinfachcommunitycouncil.co.uk ,All Councillor's were in agreement to set the domain and host charge for 5 years at a cost of £179.28, which a cheque was issued to Charlotte, The Clerk's home address will be used as the registered address of the site, The following Councillor's gave their email address to be displayed on the web site: RG Carrotte, C. Morgan, W. Thornton, Ian Robinson will advise at a later date, these address's will make up the contact page, perhaps accompanied by a photo. It was agreed that it could be seen as favouritism to have a advertising page and could cause problems further down the line, it was agreed that community based information would be displayed, such as important Local Services, e.g. Talgarth Surgery, Brecon Hospital. There would be external links to Planning and Highways Dept. It was suggested that it would be interesting to have Google Analytics to measure the quantity of hits on the site. The home page would display a collage of views of the Beacons, and local landmarks

<u>Felinfach Play Area</u> - Ian Robinson (vice chairman) gave a report of the of the Sub-Committee meeting which was held in the Griffin on Monday 14th July, The main objective initially is to get the grass to a manageable length and let it rot over the winter, and to start fund raising to be able to buy play equipment Cllr Thornton proposed that it was the Councils obligation to pay the insurance for the play equipment, on the site when the time comes, which was agreed by the Council.

<u>Purchase of land by Llanfilo Church</u> - The Clerk updated the Councillor's on the progress of the purchase, The Solicitor requires the constitution of the Community Council, which has proved difficult to track down, the Clerk to speak to PCC.

<u>Rural Grass Verges</u> -1 cut of Class 1 junctions during May, with one full unclassified roads.

<u>Pontio'r ICT</u> - IT Training for community - Clerk to find out more regarding cost and availability within the area.
