Matters Arising

St.Bilo's Church Llanfilo - Clerk sent a letter to Charles Crookes, outlining the purchase, subject to contract of the land adjacent to the church, to be used as burial ground, price for the freehold with possession is £7500, access will be from the driveway of the Old Rectory, The purchase price, and costs will be met from funds held by a committee at Llanfilo. Charles Crookes is saying that the matter will be dealt with initially by the Property Department of the Church of Wales,who will then go back to Charles Crookes once the committee stage has been properly effected, and will contact the clerk as soon as this happens.

<u>Felinfach Play Area - It was agreed that a Sub-Committee would be set up to oversee</u> the play area, The Clerk will contact Mr Owen Evitts (volunteer) to arrange a night for the first meeting, a member of the Community Council will attend the meeting, as minutes will need to be taken and incorporated into the Councils audit, there is approximately £1500 still in the play area account from previous years, which will become available to the new committee.

Mr Derek Hopkins has strimmed the area at a cost of £80.00.

Community Web Site - The Chairwomen & Clerk met with Charlotte Laine the web site designer on Monday 16th, the meeting was very productive, The web site name will be www.Felinfachcc.co.uk.to purchase the web name, will cost approx between 2.99 - 6.99 per year, to host the site will be approx £100 for 3 years, the more years you buy the cheaper it becomes and the initial setting up of the site will be £400.00, so it will cost approx.£500.00 - 600.00 for the whole package, bearing in mind that the Council has received £500.00 from the Welsh Assembly, Charlotte Laine is a local Lady, Living in Brecon, who would give additional support in the initial stages if required free of charge.
